The hospitality centre is located close to the secondary school, on the ground floor of a building shared by the arts and sciences centre. Like so much of the campus design, the hospitality centre also encourages community and is a place of meeting—a hub where school children of all ages can congregate.

A large 384-seater dining hall will bring students together from across the new school campus to receive nutritious meals and socialise with children from other year groups.

Meals cooked on site in the cafeteria kitchen and served buffet style, will promote the benefits of healthy eating and mean no child will go hungry during the day.

Multiple drinking water and hand washing stations will give women and children access to clean water, and promote good health and hygiene practices. The centre's kitchen will be built to industry standards with a large dishwashing room, spacious countertops, a cooking station, sinks, and a large, integrated storeroom.

When not in use, the entire facility will also support vocational training activities to equip students with income-generating skills and to help those interested in working in the local tourism industry graduate into employment.
