

Riverworks \$575,000

Your gift will be used to stabilise the banks of the Seti River to prevent erosion of The Pokhara Project site and give trafficking survivors a place of safety for generations to come.

Features include:

- ✓ Groundworks to prepare river banks and surrounding land for reinforcement
- ✓ Spurs: structures rooted in riverbed that protrude into river to prevent erosion of banks
- ✓ Revetments: retaining wall to prevent erosion at base of adjacent cliff
- Launching aprons to prevent removal of sediment from riverbanks and riverbed

Construction will be undertaken prior to the broader building works of The Pokhara Project.



Important riverworks to stabilise the banks of the Seti River ahead of The Pokhara Project development will take place in 2023. This crucial feat of engineering reinforces the 250-metre stretch of river adjacent to the site as a key part of constructing its sturdy, earthquake-proof foundations.

Draining excess water from the site is also crucial due to seasonal monsoons affecting the region. Every year, between June and August, the Seti River floods with the monsoon rains, depositing sediment on the riverbed and banks, and saturating the nearby land so that it also floods.

The force of the swollen river erodes the base of the adjacent cliff, putting the plateau above on which The Pokhara Project will stand at risk of eroding away.

According to local hydrologists and geotechnical engineers who surveyed the site, a viable solution to the erosion comprises a combination of spurs (structures rooted into the riverbed that protrude into the river) and revetments (retaining walls) to absorb the river's energy while protecting the base of the cliff from being swept away. Launching aprons will also be used to prevent the removal of sediment from the bed or banks of the river.
