Abuse and poor working conditions are common stories among rescued women. The stigmatism of sexual exploitation often means the heinous crimes perpetrated against them go unreported, and they can be ostracised from friends, family and the wider community, too.

The new safe haven will provide up to 40 women and girls at a time with medical care, counselling, legal assistance, vocational training and a strong supportive community as they begin the healing process.

It will be a unique place, surrounded by nature with plenty of indoor and outdoor space for a range of therapies—including singing, dancing, cooking and gardening—that are offered to help women overcome significant mental trauma.

Private and group counselling rooms will serve as sanctuaries of compassion and support.

Acute care rooms will give women suffering extreme trauma the opportunity to heal in a private, safe space. When they are ready, women will sleep in shared bedrooms, take turns to cook in the large, fully equipped kitchen, and enjoy meals in the communal dining area.

Importantly, women will find freedom, support to thrive, and be equipped with income-generating skills to become financially independent, provide for themselves and empower other women to do the same.
