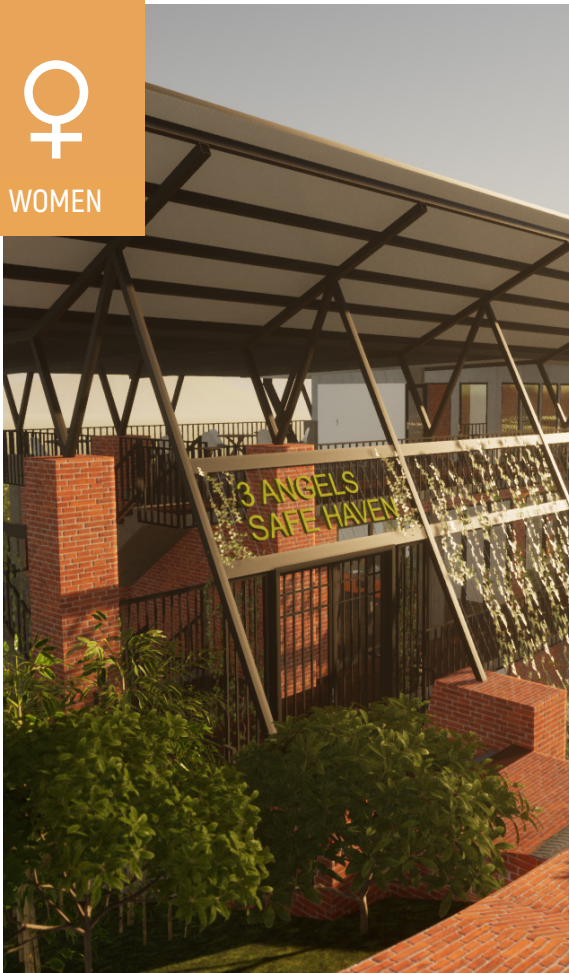
Fully funding the Women's Safe Haven will provide survivors of trafficking—women and girls as young as eight years old—with a safe place to heal. Your gift will be directed towards construction of a spacious home where vulnerable women and girls can receive life-giving care.

Features include:

- ✓ Living capacity for up to 40 women and girls at one time
- ✓ Communal and private living spaces
- ✓ Large shared bedrooms
- ✓ Private bedrooms for acute cases
- ✓ Multi-purpose counselling rooms
- ✓ On-site vocational training facilities

Construction of the new safe haven will begin once funding targets have been reached—and your generosity will take us a critical step towards achieving this important goal.

The new women's safe haven has been carefully designed to be a low maintenance sanctuary, sustainable and able to withstand Nepal's level 5 earthquakes and seasonal monsoons.

It will provide up to 40 women and girls at a time with medical care, counselling, legal support, vocational training and a strong supportive community as they begin the healing process.

Plenty of indoor and outdoor space will support a range of therapies—including singing, dancing, cooking and gardening—that are offered to help the women overcome acute mental trauma. Private and group counselling rooms will serve as sanctuaries of compassion and support.

Acute care rooms, closely monitored by qualified carers for 24/7 support, will give women suffering extreme trauma the opportunity to heal in a private, safe space. When they are

ready, women will sleep in shared bedrooms, take turns to cook in the large, fully equipped kitchen, and enjoy meals in the communal dining area.

Extra security measures such as CCTV and 24/7 on-site guards will send a comforting and much-needed message of safety.
